Paul highlighted the increase in contact from schools asking to work with them. Kate Stephen advised that this is the case across all three local authorities and there has been a significant increase in the number of offences since 2011. This could be the tip of the iceberg and Paul has concerns that schools are focusing on the drug but once you start the conversation it becomes apparent that there are other priorities and challenges at home for the young person. Where does it fit in with Children’s Services and the Named Person? Paul will re-schedule his meeting with Iain MacDonald, Children’s Wellbeing Manager and will pull together notes from this discussion and present to Children and Young People’s sub-group.</p> <p>Susan MacLaren has previously asked for a proper report/profile of people Janne Schmoock, Early Intervention Worker, Police Scotland works with and where the information goes.
